ORGANIC FARMING HELPS TO MAINTAIN ENVIRONMENT HEALTH BY REDUCING THE LEVEL OF POLLUTION. IT REDUCES HUMAN AND HEALTH HAZARD (A DANGER OR RISK) BY REDUCING THE LEVEL OF RESIDUE IN THE PRODUCTS. IT HELPS IN KEEPING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION AT A SUSTAINABLE LEVEL. UT REDUCES THE COST OF AGRICULTURE PRODUCTION AND ALSO IMPROVES THE SOIL HEALTH....





HOW ORGANIC FARMING IS USEFUL FOR US (S)

Compared with conventional agriculture organic farming uses fewer pesticides reduces soil erosion decreases nitrate leaching into groundwater and surface water and recycles animal waste back into the farm this benefits are counter balanced by higher food cost for consumers and generally lower yields
